## FRAGILITÉ FINANCIÈRE ET NOUVELLES MENACES

### RÉDUCTION DE CRISE DE LIQUIDITÉ

**15 %** Les dépenses globales sont amputées de 15 %, forçant le rapatriement de 25 % du personnel.



### LA MENACE DES DRONES (UAS)

Les attaques technologiques, comme à Kadugli et Goma, redéfinissent les risques pour les Casques bleus.



### IMPACT AU LIBAN (UNIFIL)

Plus de 13 000 déplacés à Tyr suite à l'escalade le long de la Ligne bleue.

# UN Peacekeeping at the 80-Year Crossroads: The 2026 Progress Report

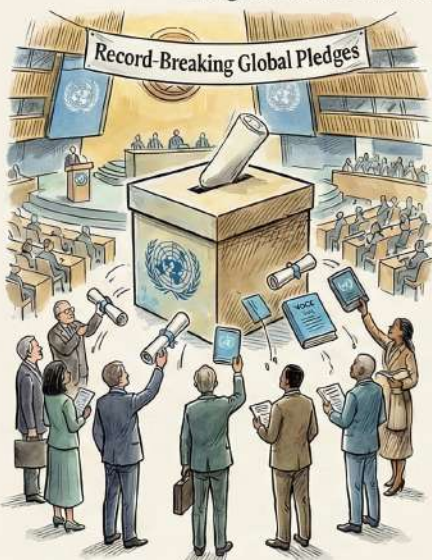

Marking the UN's 80th anniversary, the 8th "Action for Peacekeeping Plus" (A4P+) report reveals a peacekeeping apparatus operating at its limit. While political commitment and internal performance remain high, missions face a "perfect storm" of 15% budget cuts, technologically sophisticated drone warfare, and regional conflict contagion.

## Progress and Political Momentum



**Gender Parity Targets Achieved**  
All personnel categories except military contingents have successfully met Uniformed Gender Parity Strategy targets.



**High Operational Performance:**  
Over 99% of evaluated civilian and DPO staff met or exceeded performance expectations.

**74 Member States** committed critical capabilities in training and technology during the latest Ministerial.

## Emerging Threats and Constraints



**The Rise of Drone Warfare**  
Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS) represent a growing lethal threat, exemplified by recent fatal attacks in Sudan.



**15% Budgetary Contraction**  
Severe budget cuts are forcing missions toward "mandate minimalism" and strict cost-reduction measures.



**Kinetic Escalation & "Operation Epic Fury"**  
Regional wars in the Middle East have dismantled existing security architectures, straining the traditional "Blue Helmet" model.

Historical Crossroads: UN Peacekeeping navigating high-intensity regional escalations and rapid Middle East war expansion.

## REGIONAL KINETIC ESCALATIONS



### MIDDLE EAST: "OPERATION EPIC FURY"

Massive military strikes and counter-strikes dismantling regional security architecture across Lebanon and Israel.



### DRC: RISE OF DRONE WARFARE

North Kivu experiencing technologically sophisticated insurgencies despite ongoing Doha process ceasefire negotiations.



### PEACEKEEPER FATALITIES

13 fatalities due to malicious acts in 2025, largely caused by drone strikes in Kadugli.

## OPERATIONAL PERFORMANCE & A4P+ PROGRESS



### 15% GLOBAL BUDGET REDUCTION

Critical funding shortages forcing missions to shift toward "crisis diplomacy" and mandate minimalism.



### GENDER PARITY MILESTONE

Uniformed Gender Parity Strategy (UGPS) targets met for all personnel except military contingents.

### 27% PLEDGE COMPLETION RATE



Implementation Ongoing: 47%

Not Yet Implemented: 10%

Only about one-quarter of ministerial peacekeeping pledges have been fully implemented.
