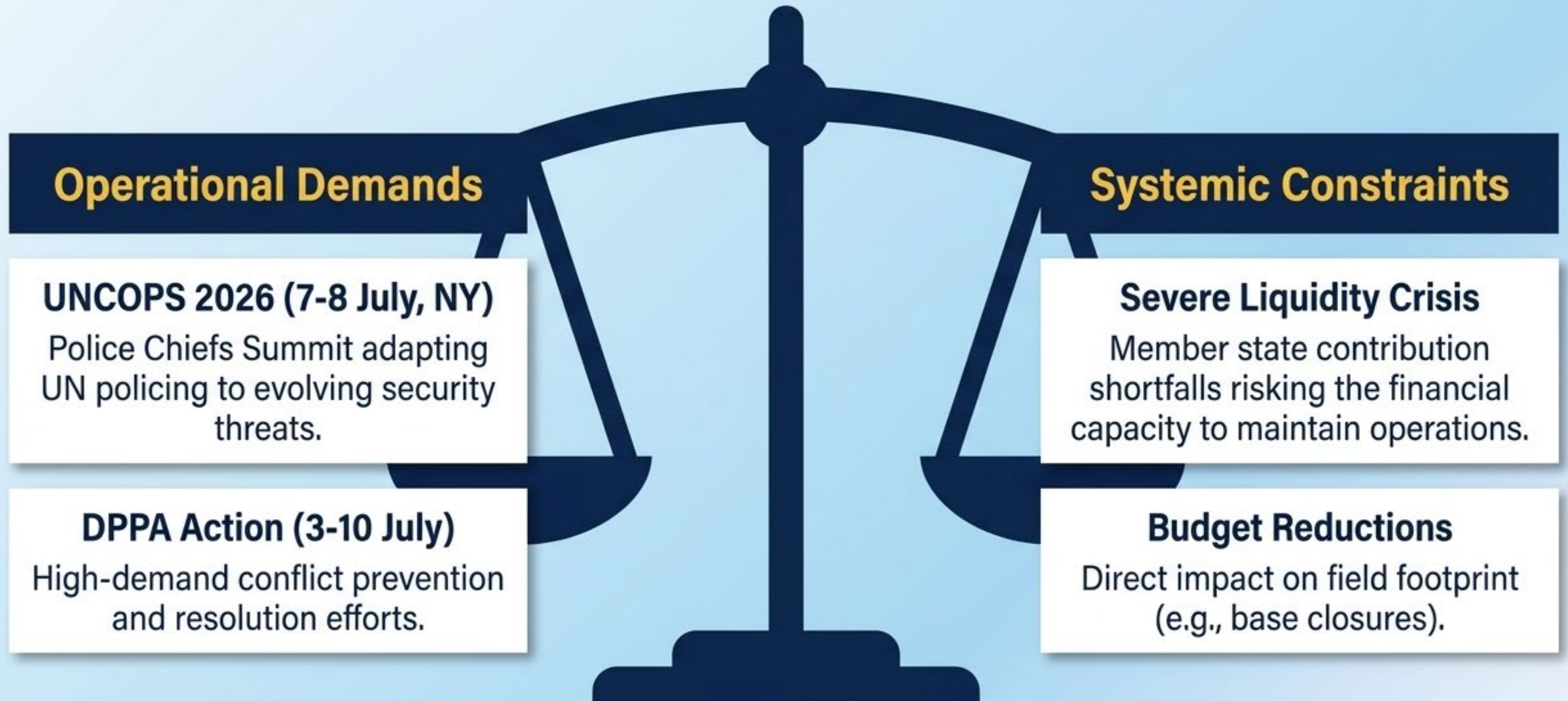
Digital Operations

Policy Response: The Anatomy of UNSC Resolution 2823

The Trigger

Adopted June 23, 2026, directly motivated by the deaths of seven UNIFIL peacekeepers earlier in the year.

The Coalition

Drafted by Denmark and Pakistan; passed unanimously with the support of 152 states.



Resolution 2823

The Legal Shift

Attacks on UN peacekeepers may constitute war crimes.

The Mandate

Urges host states to investigate/prosecute perpetrators and mandates an annual report on these investigations.

Historical Context Indicator

Previous month (June) recorded 201 airspace violations over one weekend and >2,100 firing incidents from IDF positions.

UNMISS Flashpoints: The Cycle of Fragility in Warrap State

Step 1: Constraint

15% budget cut

forces UN withdrawal from temporary Akobo Base (Jonglei State) on July 4-5.

Step 2: Escalation

Intercommunal clashes erupt in Alabek (July 2-17).

20 fatalities and 39 injuries

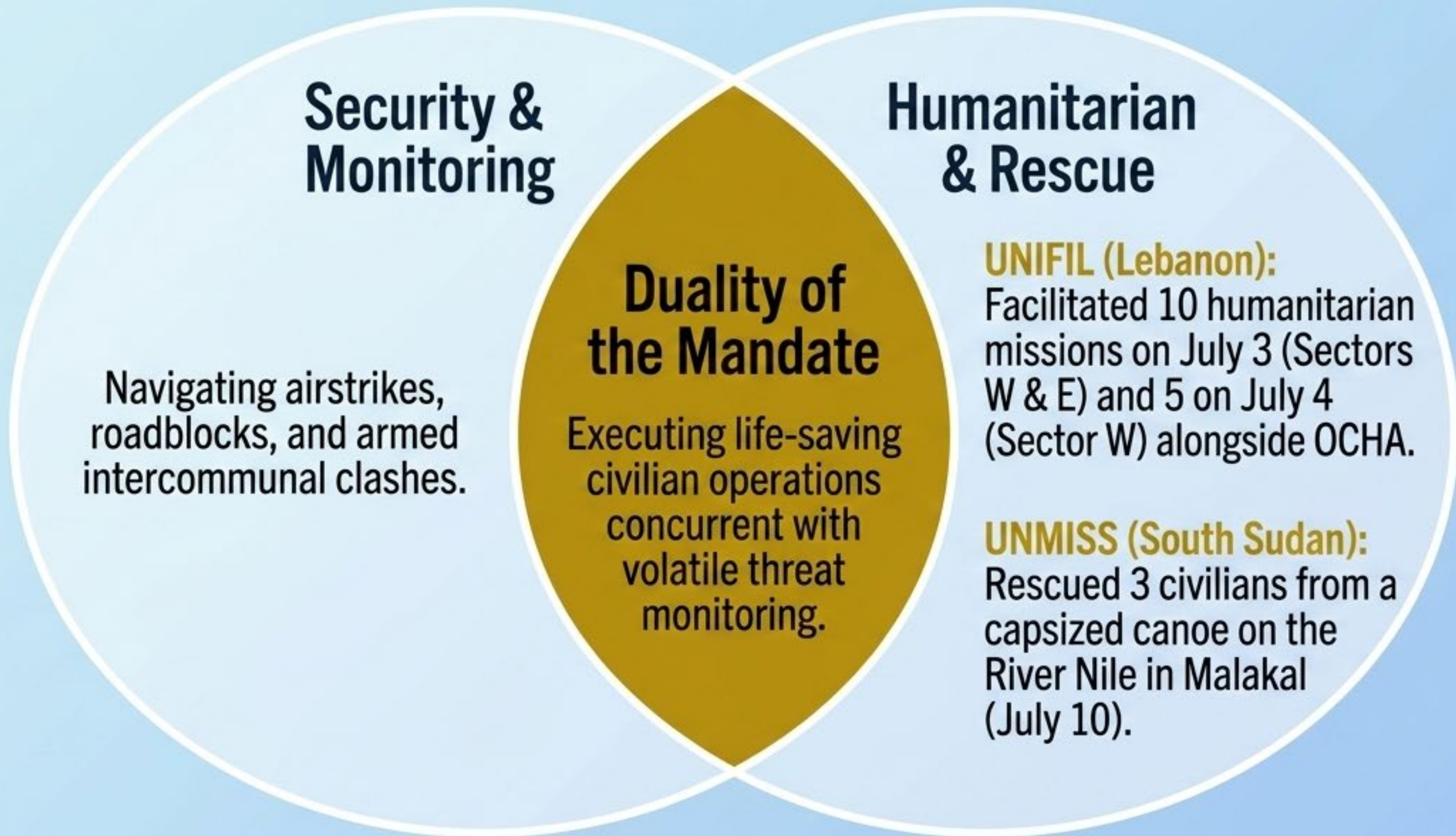
Tonj North County remains highly tense.

Step 3: Engagement

fragile calm

UNMISS establishes through intensive political engagement, strongly cautioning against retaliatory violence and promoting dialogue.
