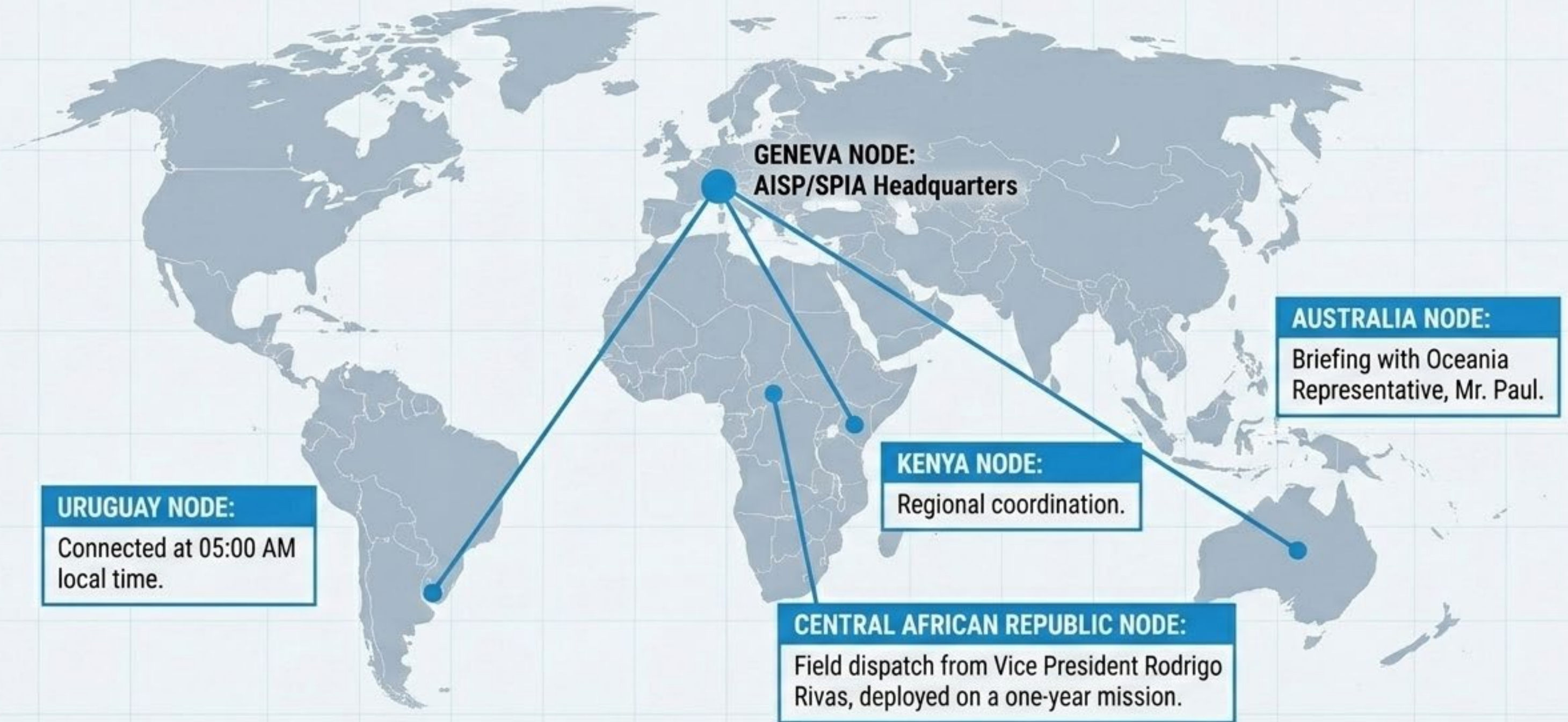

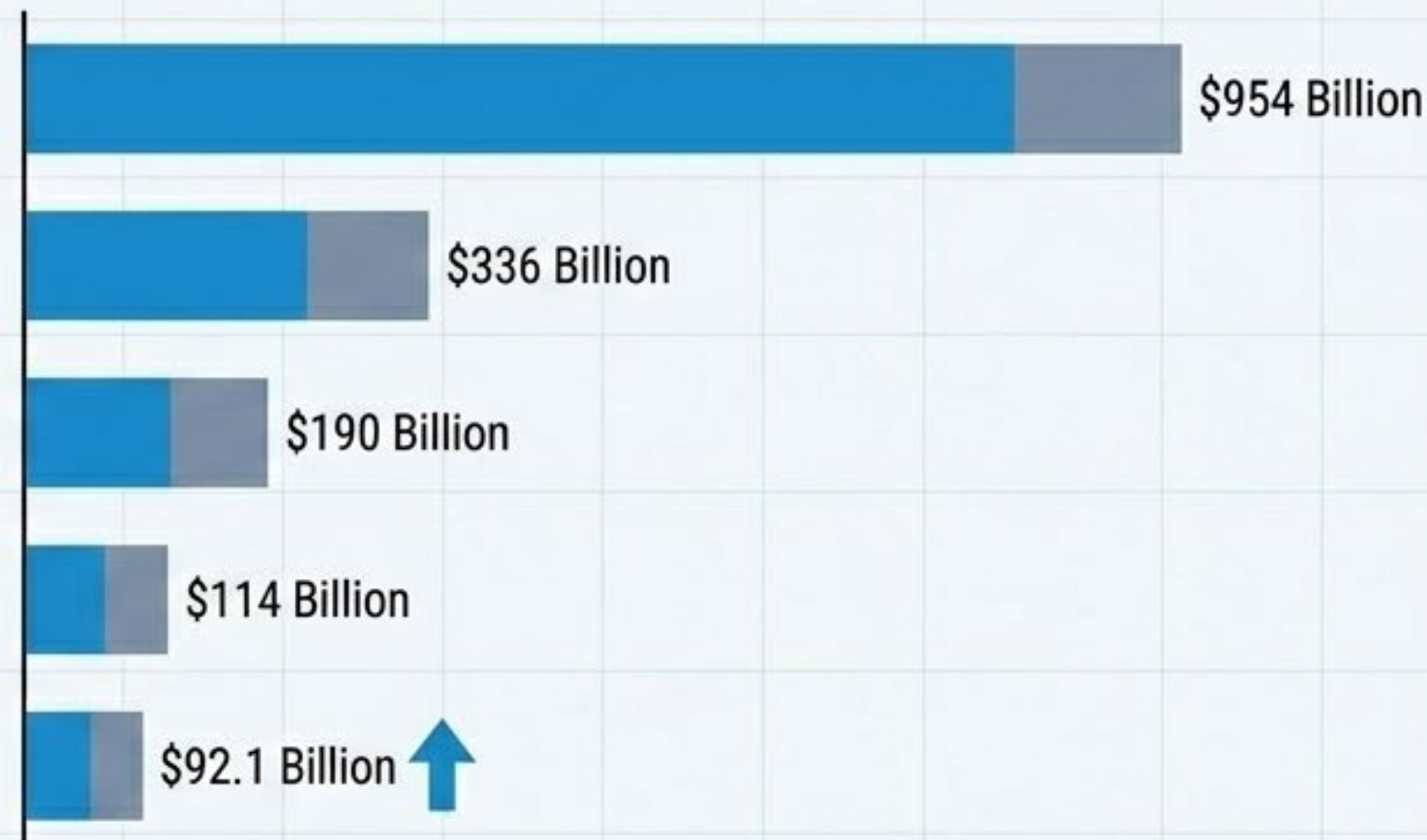

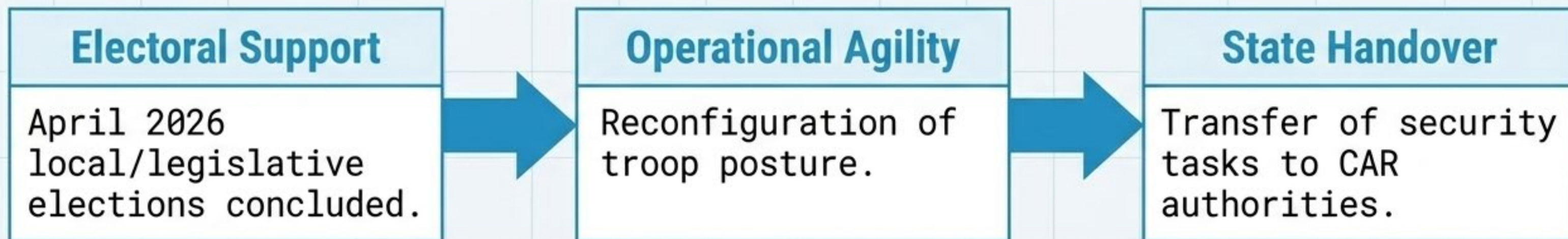
- OPCW discovers **undeclared chemical materials** in Syria.

- **110** hours of overflight

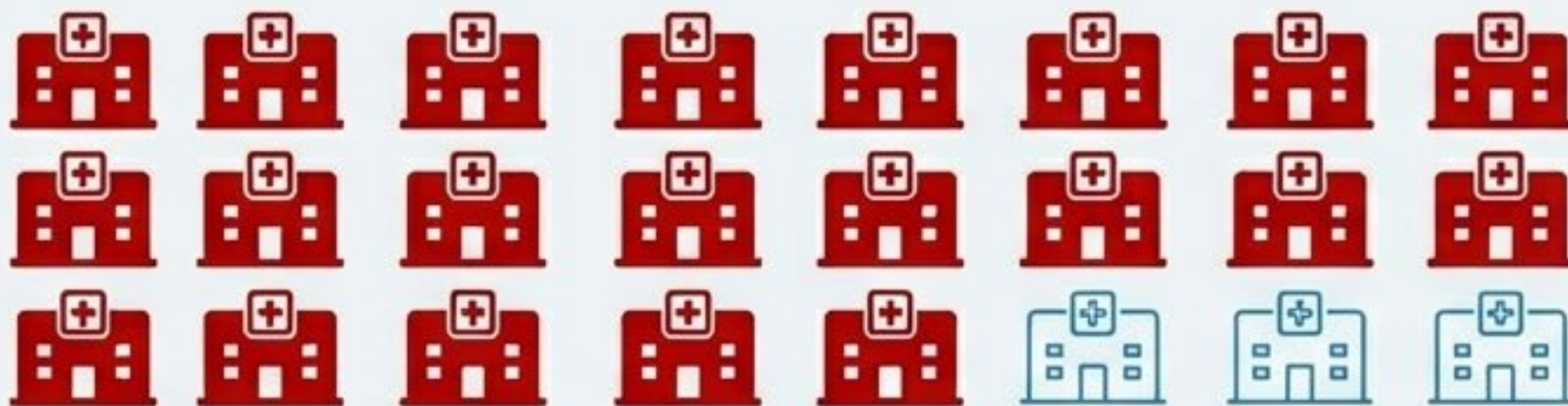
UNIFIL ACTIVITY:

HUMANITARIAN INFRASTRUCTURE TOLL (LEBANON)

- **17 HOSPITALS** damaged across Lebanon (including all 3 in Tyre).
- **135 HEALTHCARE WORKERS** and first responders killed.
- **400+ HEALTHCARE WORKERS** injured.



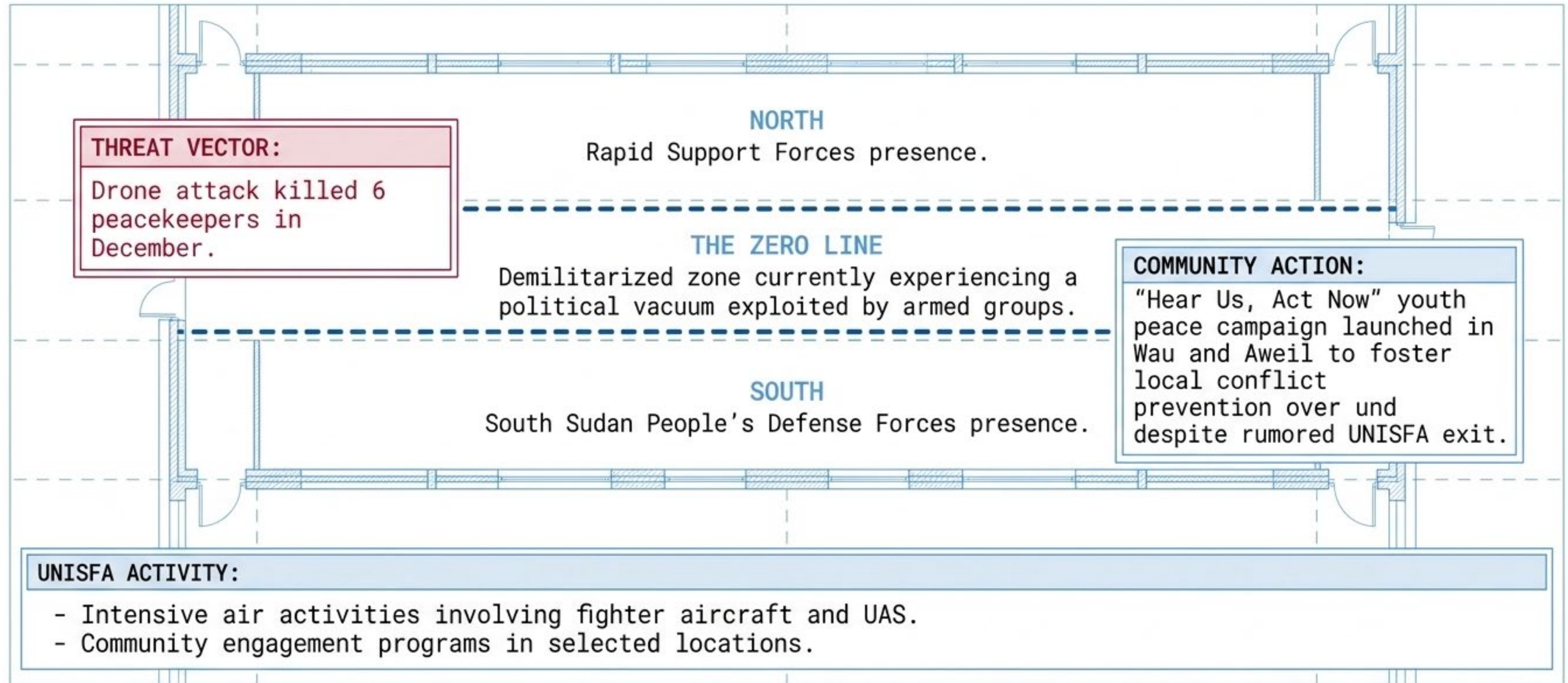
INCIDENT REPORT:

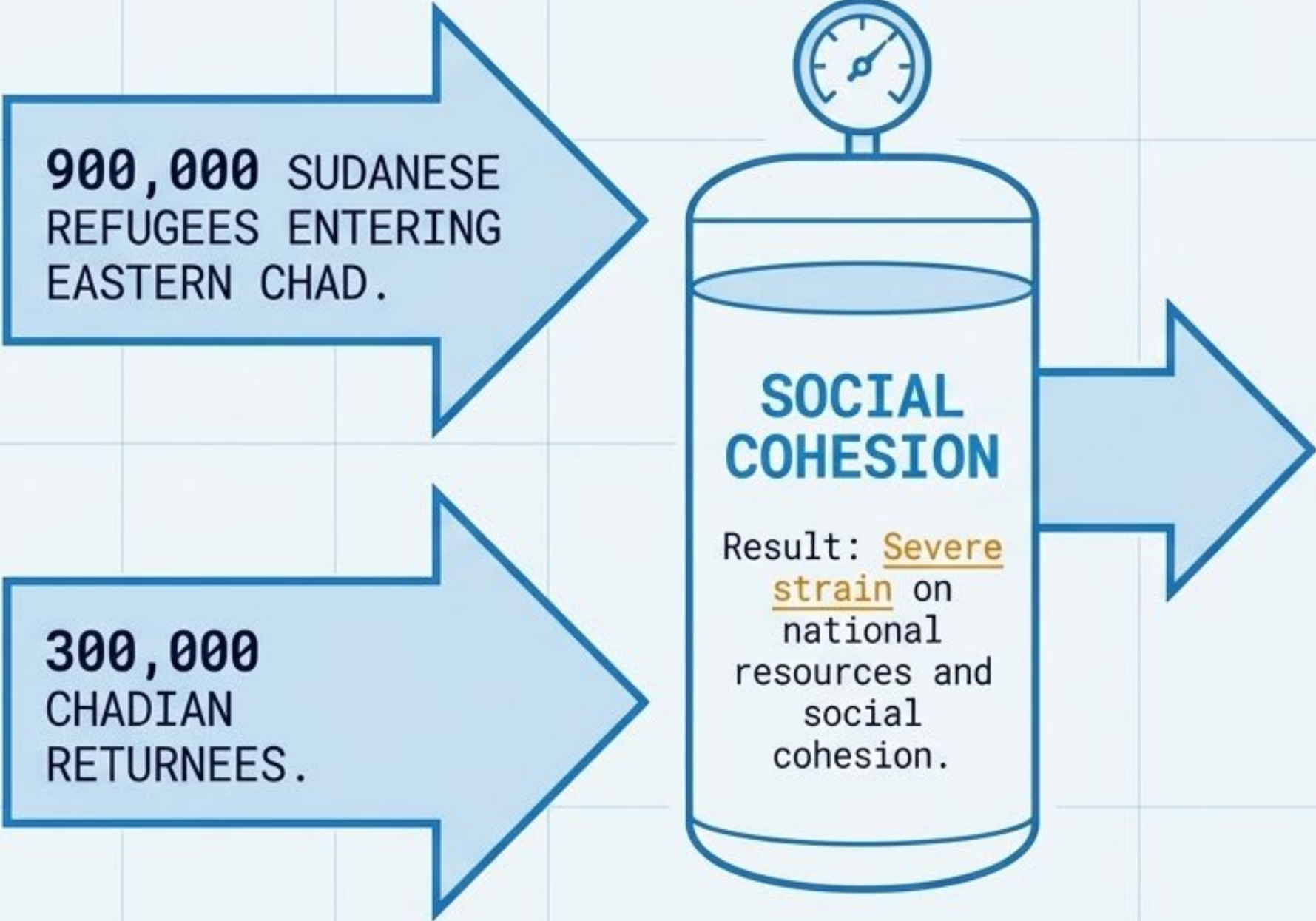

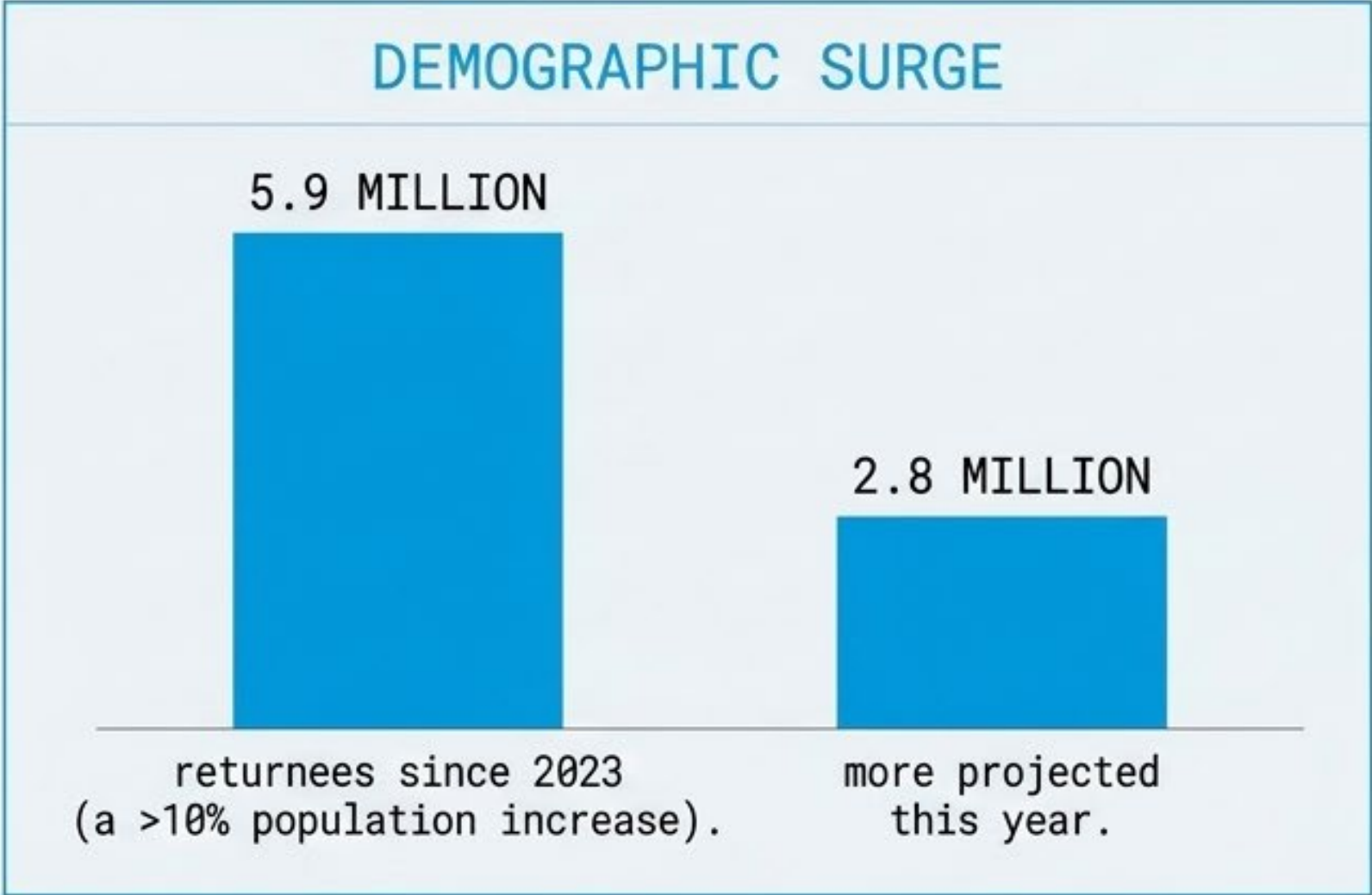
